Intro to Improvising



Improvising is a fun way to create music with other musicians! In this class we'll learn the basics of improv. and how to work together as musicians! We'll explore improv with hands on music making tailored for each age group. Have a great time exercising your creativity and making new music friends!

Intro to Songwriting



Are you interested in writing your own music but you're not sure where to start? In this class we'll discuss different ways you can approach composing. We'll create music together with hands on activities adapted to each age group. Feel free to bring your instrument if you don't play piano. We'll have keyboards available for piano players!

Intro to Voice



Students will have a blast learning the basics of singing technique and putting their new knowledge into practice! We will explore pitch matching, breath support, diction, solfege, and more, using activities and music specifically designed and chosen with developing young voices in mind.

Intro to Ukulele



Have you ever wanted to try playing the ukulele? Ukulele is one of the more accessible string instruments. After learning just a few chords you will be able to play so many popular songs!

We'll learn about the instrument, how it works, create some strum patterns, learn some chords and have a good time playing music together!

Intro to Piano/Keyboard



Piano/keyboard is one of the most important instruments in western music! No matter what instrument you play, learning piano will help you be a better musician. In this class We will explore the basics of piano technique, the music alphabet and how to find it on the piano, play songs and have a lot of fun!

Open Mic Night!



Altitudes Open Mic night will be an informal performance event for students to come together and share what they are working on! Light snacks will be available during the performance and listening activities will be provided for young students.
